**MAKE UP ONLINE. THIS IS HOW YOU DO IT:**

1. Go to <http://www.rotary.org/support/index.html>
2. Click on "Club District Support" in the menu bar at the top of the page.
3. On the list of options on the left side of the screen, highlight "Online Resources" and select "E-Clubs" from the pull down list.
4. Click on the PDF document: "Rotary E-Club Pilot Project—List of Clubs."
5. Click on the link to the club you want to make up with.
6. Follow the club's instructions. Usually they have you read and comment on some news articles about Rotary ( a minimum of 30 minutes is required.)
7. They suggest a donation to their district in the amount you would have paid for lunch at a make-up meeting.
8. They will e-mail a confirmation of your make-up to you.
9. Print the e-mail and bring it with you to the next San-Lee Rotary meeting you attend.
