## IRAN & THE US AN UPDATE

Retired US Army Lieutenant Colonel John Hillen returned as our guest speaker to give us an update on his two previous programs entitled “ Iran and the US—An Intriguing Relationship” and “The Current Crisis”.

This presentation consisted of a Question and Answer session with Rotarians asking the questions and Colonel Hillen providing the answers. In answer to the question “ Why do many Iranians dislike America ?” Colonel Hillen cited two (2) possible reasons: (1) the US support of the Shah before 1979 and (2) the US support for Iraq in the Iran—Iraq war that started in 1980. When asked if he thought Iran might use a nuclear weapon if they ac-

MAKE UP ONLINE. THIS IS HOW YOU DO IT:

1. Go to <http://www.rotary.org/support/index.html>
2. Click on “Club District Support” in the menu bar at the top of the page.
3. On the list of options on the left side of the screen, highlight “Online Resources” and select “E-Clubs” from the pull down list.
4. Click on the PDF document: “Rotary E-Club Pilot Project—List of Clubs.”
5. Click on the link to the club you want to make up with.
6. Follow the club’s instructions. Usually they have you read and comment on some news articles about Rotary ( a minimum of 30 minutes is required.)
7. They suggest a donation to their district in the amount you would have paid for lunch at a make-up meeting.
8. They will e-mail a confirmation of your make-up to you.
9. Print the e-mail and bring it with you to the next San-Lee Rotary meeting you attend.
