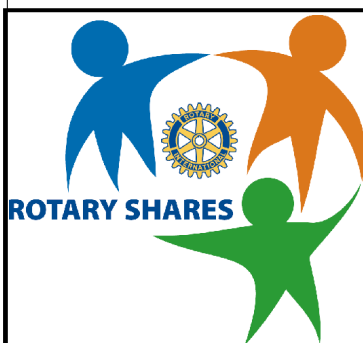

Leslie Cox introduced Hayden Lutterloh, Assistant Fire Chief for the City of Sanford, for a program describing how the Sanford Fire Department carries out the motto 'Pride Protecting People'. Hayden reviewed the equipment roster of the Department and the training and skills of the fifty-two firefighters employed by the city. The Department conducted 8000 hours of training in 2007 or about 12 hours per employee per month. This can be compared to the state requirement of only 36 hours per employee per year. The Sanford Fire Department provides an average Class 4 level of fire protection for Sanford. This Class 4 level of protection reduces the fire insurance cost for a \$200,000 home from \$1,131 per year to \$549 per year when compared to a Class 10 or lower level of protection.
