With the support of caring and generous citizens in our community the Salvation Army offers food, clothing and shelter in times of need. During a typical year the Salvation Army will provide food assistance for twenty individuals or families per week, clothing for fifteen per week and a night of lodging for two individuals or families during a month's time. The cost for these services is about fifty thousand dollars per year. The Salvation Army is a church, organized like an army and has approximately 450,000 soldiers in the United States.
