Terry Mullen introduced his daughter Julia Mullen, a planner with the Durham City-County Planning Department, for a program entitled 'Recent Developments in Development.' Durham City and County has a Unified Development Ordinance that deals with topics such as water quality, erosion control, permitting, flood plain management, telecommunications, ie. cell towers, etc. and impervious surfaces. Challenges encountered come in (1) suburban and urban development, (infill, mixed use, urban renewal), (2) billboards/ on-premise signs (electronic/digital), (3) green building/ energy conservation and sustainable development, (4) urban agriculture, (5) farmland preservation, (6) affordable housing (voluntary or mandatory). Legal issues dealt with would include (1) should local and county regulations be more stringent than state regulations, (2) takings, (3) due process, (4) building codes and (5) RLUIPA (Religious Land Use and Institutionalized Persons Act of 2000.)
