The project will be funded by a quarter cent sales tax increase to be voted on November 3rd. The school system will be able to take advantage of zero interest bonds and historically low construction cost if the project is undertaken soon. The construction and renovation project will be accomplished in four phases and should be completed by December 2011.
